On March 22, 2011, the General Government/Local Assistance Subcommittee completed its work. We are pleased to present this report, which provides detail on all the budget matters agreed to by the subcommittee, including the specific allocation of the subcommittee's target of \$12 million.

The Subcommittee reached agreement on spending and Article VII proposals for agencies and issues under the jurisdiction of this subcommittee as follows:



The Subcommittee transferred the Tribal State Compact Article VII to the General Conference Committee.

The Subcommittee allocated the \$12 million General Fund target as follows:


- \$1.96 million for a partial restoration of the Miscellaneous Financial Assistance to Madison and Oneida Counties;
- \$217,300 for a restoration of Small Government Assistance for three counties;
 - \$1.83 million for a restoration of Small Government Assistance for twenty six school districts was moved to the Education table;

- \$1.1 million for a restoration of the Tug Hill Commission;
- \$154,000 for a restoration of the Chair of the Athletic Commission's salary;
- \$176,000 for a restoration of tax assessor training;
- \$6.3 million for a restoration of Video Lottery Terminal Aid
