A679A	<b>Cahill (MS)</b> -- Adds the town of Wawarsing in Ulster county to the sites the governor is authorized to enter into tribal compacts of certain gaming facilities
A1224C	<b>Jeffries (MS)</b> -- Relates to requiring voter approval for the abolition or modification of term limits for certain elected offices
A1313	<b>Brodsky (MS)</b> -- Establishes a closed-circuit television system and surveillance personal privacy act
A1833	<b>Dinowitz (MS)</b> -- Relates to penalties for the illegal shipment of cigarettes
A2323	<b>Jeffries (MS)</b> -- Prohibits more than one increase in the price of motor fuel in any twenty-four hour period

A2642B	<b>Pheffer (MS)</b> -- Relates to subscription expiration notice requirements for magazines
A3168	<b>Bradley (MS)</b> -- Requires that individuals convicted of certain animal cruelty and animal fighting offenses reimburse the organizations caring for such animals
A4054	<b>Gantt (MS)</b> -- Relates to the comprehensive school bus driver safety training program
A4234	<b>Giglio</b> -- Authorizes the county of Cattaraugus to impose an additional 25 cents per \$100 mortgage recording tax
A4300	<b>Canestrari (MS)</b> -- Provides that actions by the attorney general for unlawful practice of law shall include both civil and criminal actions
A4632A	<b>Thiele</b> -- Relates to granting peace officer status to uniformed members of the fire marshall's office in the village of Southampton
A4633A	<b>Thiele</b> -- Designates employees of the village court of the village of Westhampton Beach serving as uniformed court officers as peace officers
A4758A	<b>Morelle (MS)</b> -- Relates to standard fire insurance policies
A4768A	<b>Jordan</b> -- Authorizes the county of Washington to impose hotel or motel taxes
A4790	<b>Weinstein</b> -- Extends until 2014 the provisions of chapter 455 of the laws of 1997 conferring certain powers on New York city marshals
A5311A	<b>Sayward</b> -- Designates the village of Lake George seasonal constables as peace officers
A5617	<b>Errigo (MS)</b> -- Requires certain information given to parent and consent be obtained without coercion for temporary removal of child with consent
A5709A	<b>Conte (MS)</b> -- Designates uniformed officers of the fire marshal's office of the town of Huntington as peace officers

A5902	<b>Rivera P (MS)</b> -- Provides that directors of in-patient facilities and hospitals shall designate safety officers to act as special policeman
A6061	<b>Kavanagh (MS)</b> -- Relates to the disqualification of tax delinquent bidders with some exceptions
A6190	<b>Titus (MS)</b> -- Provides a tax check off box on personal income tax return forms for the life pass it on trust fund
A6421A	<b>Butler</b> -- Relates to amending the authorization for the imposition of additional sales and compensating use tax in Herkimer county
A6453	<b>Ortiz (MS)</b> -- Directs commissioner of education to facilitate a program to coordinate the donation of excess, unused, edible food from school meal programs to voluntary food assistance programs
A6812	<b>Kavanagh (MS)</b> -- Removes a certain time period in which an adult receives cash assistance in the safety net program
A6818A	<b>Morelle</b> -- Creates a residential care off-site demonstration project
A6883	<b>Hawley</b> -- Extends the period during which the county of Genesee is authorized to impose a county recording tax on certain mortgage obligation
A6884	<b>Hawley</b> -- Extends the period during which the county of Orleans is authorized to impose additional rates of sales and compensating use taxes
A7016	<b>Eddington</b> -- Authorizes a court to order the confidentiality of election registration records of a victim of domestic violence

A7455	<b>Bacalles</b> -- Extends authorization of the county of Yates to impose an additional one percent of sales and compensating use taxes until November 30, 2011
A7462	<b>Giglio (MS)</b> -- Extends expiration of authorization of county of Allegany to impose additional 1 1/2% sales and compensating use taxes until November 30, 2011
A7545B	<b>Millman (MS)</b> -- Specifies what constitutes appropriate shelter for dogs restrained outdoors and maximum and minimum temperature range for exposure
A7670	<b>Gottfried (MS)</b> -- Relates to motions to vacate judgment against victims of sex trafficking for certain prostitution offenses
A7868	<b>O'Mara</b> -- Designates animal control officers employed by the county of Schuyler as peace officers

A7949A	<b>Silver (MS)</b> -- Authorizes superintendent of insurance to approve a demonstration program where an eligible insurer issues group health insurance policies to eligible associations
A8049	<b>Zebrowski</b> -- Authorizes the attorney general to bring an action for violation of the prohibitions concerning unlawful selling practices and specifies damages awardable
A8103A	<b>Pretlow</b> -- Provides for accelerated payments to the city school district of the city of Mount Vernon
A8105	<b>Jeffries (MS)</b> -- Provides that supervision fees for parolees shall be collected at a central location and shall not be collected by parole officers
A8115	<b>Butler</b> -- Amends chapter 489 of the laws of 2004, relating to the mortgage recording tax in the county of Fulton, to extend the effectiveness of such chapter
A8252A	<b>Townsend</b> -- Designates a portion of the state highway system in the village of Holland Patent as the "Marine Lance Cpl. Blaise Oleski Memorial Highway"
A8333A	<b>Boyle</b> -- Grants uniform members of the bureau of fire prevention of the town of Islip peace officer status
A8347	<b>Gunther</b> -- Extends the authority of Sullivan county to impose a sales and compensating use tax within such county
A8354	<b>Amedore</b> -- Designates federal Security and Safeguard Division personnel assigned to the U.S. Department of Energy Naval Reactors Laboratory Field Offices as peace officers

A8459A	<b>Galef</b> -- Extends the imposition of sales and compensating use taxes in Putnam county
A8499	<b>Gottfried</b> -- Provides that the commissioner of health shall report improper measures by manufacturers, suppliers or retailers to attorney general which cause exposure to lead

A8617	<b>Farrell (MS)</b> -- Amends certain provisions of the New York state financial emergency act for the city of New York in relation to bond anticipation notes
A8629	<b>Sayward</b> -- Extends from December 1, 2009 until December 1, 2012, the expiration of the authority of the county of Hamilton to impose a mortgage tax

A8713	<b>Cymbrowitz (MS)</b> -- Relates to the effectiveness of a chapter authorizing sweepstakes with respect to subscriptions to The Conservationist
A8825A	<b>Cahill (MS)</b> -- Extends provisions of law relating to low cost power
A8866	<b>Farrell (MS)</b> -- Increases certain sales and compensating use taxes in N.Y. city

S148	<b>SAMPSON</b> -- Designates January twenty-seventh as a day of commemoration to be named Holocaust Remembrance Day

S179	<b>SEWARD</b> -- Authorizes the county of Greene to impose an additional mortgage recording tax of 50 cents per \$100 of debt
S1664	<b>KRUEGER</b> -- Creates a duty to reinspect and abate hazardous activities in violation of the New York city building code and zoning ordinance
S1788	<b>STEWART-COUSINS</b> -- Authorizes Gate of Heaven cemetery to transfer land to the Cemetery Floral Company
S2760	<b>MONSERRATE</b> -- Establishes the reverse mortgage fairness act of 2009
S3357	<b>ONORATO</b> -- Requires employers to give written notice of the rate of pay and the regular pay day upon hiring, and get written acknowledgment thereof from each employee
S3784	<b>THOMPSON</b> -- Extends the special powers of the New York state environmental facilities corporation
S4768	<b>BRESLIN</b> -- Enacts the fraternal benefit society risk based capital act of 2009; establishing risk-based capital requirements applicable to fraternal benefit societies; repealer
