Protecting Children and Teachers

After almost a year of pushing back against the administration that the common core curriculum was simply not working and we should not link high-stakes testing with teacher performance, the Governor is finally listening. For fifteen years, our schools have been misguided by top-down incentive-based programs. Enough is enough. No child in our public schools should be taught to the test. Every child deserves to learn with passion and purpose.

Investing in Education

Last year, we voted to bring \$9.2 billion for New York City Schools, which is about \$500 million more than last year; \$75 million in grants for struggling schools; and \$20 million in grants for libraries, teacher centers, and bilingual education. We need to continue to fight for our public schools and make sure we receive the funding that our teachers and children deserve.
