**The state budget releases \$2.5 billion for affordable housing and anti-homelessness initiatives and provides:**

- \$1 billion to construct supportive housing
- \$200 million for NYCHA capital repairs
- \$125 million for senior housing
- \$100 million for 100% Affordable Housing in NYC
- \$75 million for Mitchell-Lama preservation programs
- \$4.5 million for the Tenant Protection Unit to investigate landlord fraud and neglect
- \$2 million for Naturally Occurring Retirement Communities (NORCs) and Neighborhood Naturally Occurring Retirement Communities (NNORCs) to help seniors stay in their neighborhoods
