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Assemblywoman Walker is helping New Yorkers fight breast cancer

Walker passed a law to make breast cancer screenings more accessible and affordable so cases are caught in the earliest, most treatable stages (**A.10679**). The measure:

-  **Improves insurance coverage** by prohibiting annual deductibles, co-payments and co-insurance payments for mammograms, breast ultrasounds and MRIs
-  **Requires extended hours of screening** at more hospitals and clinics
-  **Gives New York City public employees the right** to paid leave for screenings
