

## New York State is failing its teachers, students, and their parents.

ASSEMBLYMAN DAN STEC AND THE MINORITY CONFERENCE HAVE PROPOSED THE APPLE PLAN TO REFORM COMMON CORE

- Assessments and
  Curriculum: Stop the rushed implementation and create an independent teacher panel to develop, review, and approve age/developmentally-appropriate curriculum and assessments based on Common Core Guidelines.
- Funding Equity: Eliminate the GEA, allowing our schools to get the resources they need while easing the strain on taxpayers.

- Restrict Use of Student
  Data: Limit the disclosure of
  student information by a school
  district or private school.
  Require written parental consent
  or written consent of eligible
  students (18 years old).
- 21st Century Pathways: Create alternate pathways to a high school diploma including a Career and Technical Education pathway. Increase state funding for BOCES.
- Provide Equity for Special-Needs Students: Work with a special education student's IEP team to decide on the best course of action and ensure it is not trumped by Common Core's rigidity.
