In January 2013, Assemblyman Magnarelli joined with U.S. Senator Kirsten Gillibrand in urging Federal administration officials fund Weatherization Assistance Programs. Senator Gillibrand said, "During these tough economic times, many New Yorkers simply cannot afford this added strain on their budgets – especially since New Yorkers already pay more than the national average for energy costs. Weatherization programs help save families hundreds on energy costs while supporting local construction, small businesses, and manufacturing jobs."
