

> **Enhanced STAR** reduces the taxable value of your home, resulting in significant school tax savings. To be eligible, you must have a household income of less than \$86,000. More information can be found online at www.tinyurl.com/EnhancedStar.

Senior Citizens Homeowners'

Exemption reduces your home's assessed value by up to 50 percent. Applicants must have a household annual income of \$37,400 or less to become eligible. To see if you qualify, visit your Town Hall located at 475 Calkins Road, or call your town assessor at (585) 359-7034.
