Standing up for immigrants

- Co-sponsored the Jose Peralta New York State DREAM Act to ensure all students, regardless of citizenship status, can pursue a higher education (Ch. 26 of 2019)
- Championed the Driver's License Access and Privacy Act, known as the Green Light law, which allows undocumented New Yorkers to apply for a driver's license (Ch. 37 of 2019)

Strengthening our kids' education

- Secured more than \$14 million in additional funding for area schools
- Provided an additional \$150,000 for the Brentwood Union Free School District to expand the My Brother's Keeper initiative to increase opportunities for young men of color
- Fought to give control back to teachers, parents and local school districts by decoupling student test scores and teacher evaluations (Ch. 27 of 2019)

Keeping our communities safe

- Fought to ban firearms that are not detectable by metal detectors or X-rays (A.763-A)
- Passed safe storage legislation requiring gun owners to lock up firearms if there are children or dangerous individuals in the house (A.2686-A)
