Clean Water, Safe Roads

As Ranking Minority Member of the Assembly's Transportation Committee, Dave McDonough is fighting for safe and reliable roads and bridges, and to preserve Long Island's water quality.

- ✓ \$100 million for both PAVE-NY and Bridge NY to ensure our families are safe traveling to and from school and work.¹
- ✓ Restoration of the \$65 million Extreme Winter Recovery Fund, helping our local municipalities and highway departments restore our roads after harsh winters.²
- ✓ An increase in Consolidated Local Street and Highway Improvement Program funding of \$100 million, raising it to \$538.1 million.³
- ✓ Continuation of the \$2.5 billion Clean Water Infrastructure Act and an additional \$500 million this year to update drinking and wastewater infrastructure throughout New York.⁴
- ✓ A companion for the CHIPS program, offering financial assistance to local governments for drinking, storm, and sewer water infrastructure, called the Water Infrastructure Investment Program (WIIPS).⁵
