# **2017 SESSION HIGHLIGHTS**

Assemblyman Michael Montesano worked hard to make sure New York's seniors were a priority during the 2017 Session.

Accomplishments include the passage of legislation and securing funds to:

- Require the Department of Health and the Office of the Aging to take a look at, and make recommendations on, all fees and charges to residents in assisted living facilities on or before April 1, 2019. (A.3061)
- Eliminate annuity roll over from being classified as taxable income so seniors can receive benefits at the same rate. (A.1603)
- Extend Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program's authorization to advocate on behalf of long-term patients until December 31, 2019. (A.8105)
- Expedite any claims in which a senior is being victimized. (A.2394)
- Instruct the Senior Citizens Rent Increase Exemption (SCRIE) and the Disability Rent Increase Exemption (DRIE) programs to create outreach initiatives to inform eligible but non-participating seniors. (A.6037)
- Require numerous groups to set higher standards to stop financial exploitation of the elderly. (A.6395)
- Require the Office for the Aging to add the number of older adults who are guardians to minors and an analysis of substance use disorders among the elderly population to its annual report. (A.6736)



To highlight November as National Alzheimer's Disease Awareness Month, Assemblyman Montesano hosted a Memory Screening event on November 1st at the Westbury Senior Citizens Center. Any constituents over the age of 65 were encouraged to go as Alzheimer's disease affects over 5 million Americans.
