Greetings -

This past Sunday saw heavy rains in the Northeast again causing flash flooding, power outages, and canceled airline flights. My bill (A7876) regarding flood disclosure for tenants, which was signed into law by the Governor in December, became effective this June 21st. The new law requires residential leases to include notice of flood risk and flood history as well as notice to tenants of flood insurance available to renters. This legislation will help provide renters the information they need to make good decisions regarding flood risk to protect their families and possessions.
