


68 Street Hunter College Station Project

#### Reconstruction of York Ave. Combined Sewer and Water Main

The NYC Department of Design and Construction (NYC DDC) manages the Reconstruction of York Avenue, Combined Sewer, and Water Main Project ID# SEN002169, upgrading existing infrastructure facilities along York Avenue, between East 61st Street and East 63rd Street and on E. 62nd Street between York Avenue and 1st Avenue in the Upper East Side of Manhattan. The city's scope includes replacing combined sewers, water mains, catch basins, fire hydrants, new street lighting, traffic signal upgrades, and full road restoration. *Several of these operations have been delayed due to Con Edison's underground utility work, which requires extreme caution and handdigging excavations. The anticipated completion date for this project is winter 2024.*
