

Assemblyman Benedetto helped raise the minimum wage!

In New York City:

- The minimum wage is now \$11 per hour
- It will continue to increase each year by \$2 until it hits \$15 per hour in 2019
- For businesses with 10 or fewer employees, the minimum wage is now \$10.50 and it will continue to increase \$1.50 each year until it reaches \$15 in 2020
