

Dear Constituent,

While our office may be closed today in observance of Veterans Day, my commitment to our veterans is open-ended. Those who risk their lives to defend our nation deserve our support, and we must pay more than lip service for the sacrifices these men and women have made.

I have consistently taken action to support veterans in our area, starting with opting the Town of Ossining into state legislation enabling property tax exemptions for veterans during my time as Supervisor. This year, I co-sponsored legislation to establish New York State commemorative medals for <u>Iraq</u> and <u>Afghanistan</u> War veterans, and brought home \$20,000 for CHHOP's Welcome Home for Veterans program. During the budget process, I also pushed for \$2.8 million in restorations and additions for various veterans' services and not-for-profits serving veterans.
