The 2016-17 state budget marks the largest investment in New York's education system, a total of \$24.7 billion, including:

- \$807 million for pre-K
 programs to continue to foster
 early childhood development
- \$175 million to convert schools into community schools that will benefit at-risk youth and their families

- \$14.3 million for Teacher Resource and Computer Training Centers
