Responding to Our Community's Needs

- Since 2013, Assemblyman William B. Magnarelli has secured more than \$1.5 million in state grant funding to further enhance the Syracuse City Police Department's COPS (Criminal Observation and Protection System) surveillance camera project. These funds have made a huge difference for residents living in our city neighborhoods, as well as for police officers in their efforts to keep our neighborhoods safe.
- More than 100 cameras are purchased and installed with these grant funds located throughout our city, including but not limited to these areas: North Salina Street, Butternut Street, E. Fayette St., Hawley-Green Historic District, Washington Square, Park Street and West Genesee Street area.
- 12 cameras located in Schiller Park and 9 cameras in Upper Onondaga Park.
- \$225,000 in grants have been secured to install additional cameras on the Northside, and 5 cameras on James Street in Eastwood.
