VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

AARP Foundation Tax-Aide Shift Goordinator - Under the direction of the Local Coordinator, the Shift Coordinator (SCO) is responsible for coordinating and managing all phases of site operations at a specific site during an assigned period of time (shift) acting for the Local Coordinator (LC).

Client Facilitator - The Client Facilitator (CF) works with the Local Coordinator/Shift Coordinator, performs check-in duties, provides an important first contact to the AARP Foundation Tax-Aide program for taxpayers, and manages taxpayers' initial activities.

Counselor - Counselors, under the direction of the Local Coordinator or Shift Coordinator, provide tax assistance and preparation services to taxpayers.

Electronic Return Originator - The Electronic Return Originator (ERO) works with the Local/Shift Coordinator (LC/SCO), the Technology Coordinator (TC), and the Counselors to electronically file federal and state tax returns with the IRS and state Department of Taxation and Finance via IRS-provided tax preparation software (TaxWise) and the software provider (CCHSFS).

Local Coordinator - The Local Coordinator (LC) implements program plans in one or more assigned geographic localities and ensures site compliance with AARP Foundation Tax-Aide program policies and IRS Quality Site Requirements.

 coverage, or vice versa.
- Enroll in a Medicare prescription drug plan.
- Jump from one Medicare drug plan to a different Medicare drug plan.
- Quit your Medicare prescription drug coverage.
