Did You Know...?

- Outside of NYC, nearly **80% of fire protection services** are provided by volunteer departments.
- The state has **lost thousands of volunteer firefighters** and EMS responders in recent years, leaving a tremendous unmet need in our rural communities.
- While the number of volunteer firefighters across New York State has significantly decreased, the annual call volume has nearly doubled over the past 30 years. from 750,000 to 1.4 million.
- Since the COVID-19 pandemic, approximately 30 volunteer ambulance corps closed their doors due to the overwhelming loss of valuable, well-trained personnel.
- Benefits for emergency volunteers include a **state** income tax credit, a real property tax exemption, a length of service award program, and college tuition **reimbursement** through the FASNY Help Program.
- The annual cost on the property taxpayer of an all-paid fire service would be \$4.7 billion.
