**Mike Norris may be our new Assemblyman, but he's a lifelong Western New Yorker and not new to fighting for the values we hold most important at our state Capitol. Mike knows we need strong leadership now more than ever, and he's been working hard to bring his **"Back to Basics" priorities to Albany:****

- ✓ **Restore Fiscal Responsibility in Albany:** Mike holds the line against bloated, secretive, and fiscally irresponsible state spending. Since first being elected, he has voted 34 times against more than \$35.6 billion in tax hikes!\*
- ✓ **Invest in Our Local Infrastructure:** Mike Norris knows we should be investing in local infrastructure to provide the vital services we need daily. He has advocated for historic funding increases for our local roads, bridges, highways, culverts, and water and sewer lines in need of repairs. Mike has delivered from Lake Ontario to the Erie Canal, and worked to expand the Discover Niagara Shuttle into Lockport.
- ✓ **Change the Way NYS Does Business:** Since first being elected in 2016, reforming the dysfunction and corruption in Albany has been a priority for Mike Norris. The first bill he introduced was the State Contracts Sunlight Act (A.3784 of 2022), and he's proud to have been part of bipartisan efforts to enact a similar provision known as the "Database of Deals" into law last year.

**Mike Norris is not only a leader in our community but also in Albany.** He serves as the Chairman of the Assembly Minority Conference and as a member of the Rules and Ways and Means committees, providing key oversight of the State Budget process. As a member of the Assembly Judiciary Committee, he was involved in the investigation that led to the resignation of former Governor Andrew Cuomo and he has also advocated hard for local infrastructure projects as a member of the Assembly Transportation Committee.
