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## **ASSEMBLYMAN PERRY ANNOUNCES COMPETITION FOR 2011 COMMUNITY AWARENESS COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP**

**Brooklyn, NY** – Assemblyman N. Nick Perry announced the start of the essay competition for his **2011 Annual Community Awareness College Scholarship Awards**. The scholarship is for NYC high school seniors who reside in the 58<sup>th</sup> Assembly District and have applied for admission to an accredited college or university for the Fall 2011 semester.

Assemblyman N. Nick Perry's 2011 Community Awareness Scholarship will include **one (1) Grand Prize Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000** and **two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$500**. **One of the three scholarships will be set aside for a graduating senior from the Samuel J. Tilden Educational Campus.**

Any student interested in participating in the competition will be required to submit a two-page essay on one of the following three topics: **1) *If I Were an Elected Official, I Would Help to Improve...* 2) *It Is Important To Participate in Community Activities Because...* 3) *A day in my life that most influenced me to create positive change was...***

# 2011 COMMUNITY AWARENESS COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Assemblyman Nick Perry's 2011 Community Awareness Scholarship will include **one (1) Grand Prize Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000** and **two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$500** for graduating high school seniors who **reside in the 58<sup>th</sup> Assembly District-see map.**

**One of the three scholarships must be awarded to a graduating senior from the Samuel J. Tilden Educational Campus.** The following provides further explanation of criteria:

- a graduating high school senior
- a current resident of the 58<sup>th</sup> Assembly District
- proof of acceptance and enrollment (Fall, 2011) as a college freshman
- submission of a two-page essay on one of the following topics:

***1) If I were an elected official, I would help to improve...***

***2) It is important to participate in community activities because...***

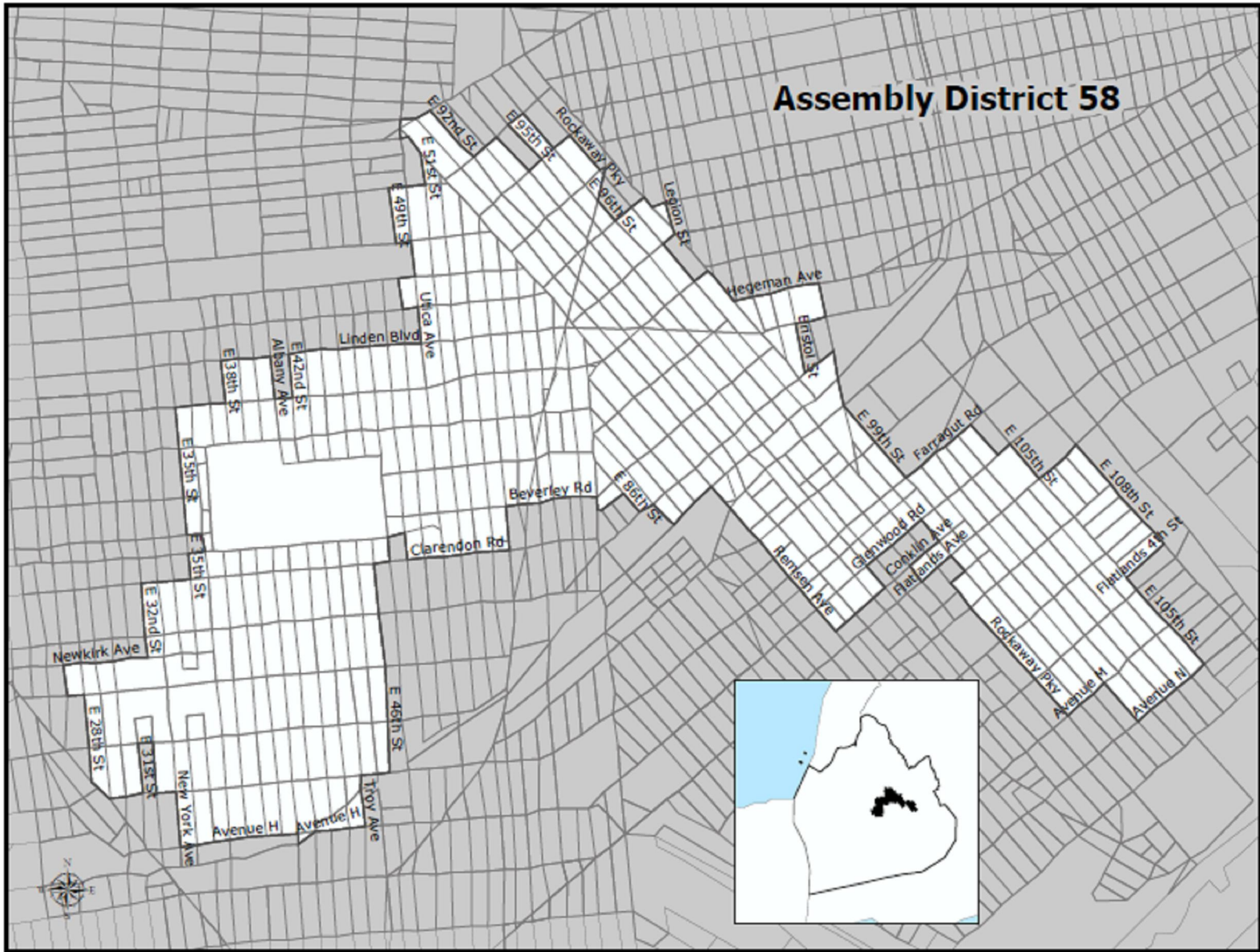
***3) A day in my life that most influenced me to create positive change was...***

Essays must have the applicant's name on the top, right hand-side of each page.
