Legislative Update for Veterans



Assemblyman Hawley served seven years in the Army National Guard and Army Reserves. As a veteran and the ranking minority member of the Veterans' Affairs Committee, Assemblyman Hawley has made it one of his top priorities to support veterans.

This year, Assemblyman Hawley is sponsoring the following veteran-specific legislation that:

- Creates a tax credit for employers who hire New York National Guard personnel (A.4010).
- Provides an exemption to disabled veterans from payment of New York Thruway tolls (A.11269-A).
- Issues special license plates for gold star families who have lost a son or daughter while in service to our country (A.10802-A).
- Provides scholarships to surviving family members of NYS military personnel who died in the line of duty (A.4005).
- Allows military personnel to exempt income from the state income tax during active service (A.4006).
