health care decisions should remain between a woman and her doctor. New Yorkers deserve the freedom to make decisions about their health and future.

I will always vote to keep it that way and will continue to support health care proposals that would:

- ✓ Create paid family leave after a stillbirth.¹
- ✓ Require health care facilities to report incidents of a sexual offense to the departments of health and education.²
- ✓ Ensure certain insurers provide coverage for prenatal vitamins that help promote a healthy pregnancy.³
- ✓ Implement the first-in-nation paid prenatal leave of up to 20 hours over any 52-week period.⁴
- ✓ Necessitate health insurance policies to cover comprehensive screening and biomarker testing for ovarian and prostate cancers.⁵
