**New York State Golden Park Program-** If you are a New York State resident 62 or older, on Monday-Friday, except holidays, you can obtain free vehicle access to most state parks, boat launch sites, arboretums and fee reductions for state historic sites and state-operated golf courses.

Simply present your current, valid NYS Driver's license or NYS non-driver identification card at the park entrance. No application is required, as your driver's license/non-driver ID serves as your pass.
