As 2025 comes to an end, so does my first year representing our community in the New York State Assembly. Meeting many community leaders across the 11th District has been an incredible privilege, and I am deeply grateful to be entrusted to serve you and your loved ones. I will always be a strong voice for our families in Albany and fight to get our fair share.

This year, we secured significant investments to help our neighborhoods thrive. In the enacted 2025-26 state budget, we secured record funding for our schools, public spaces and seniors' services. I also introduced, co-sponsored and passed legislation to rebuild our infrastructure, support our children and families, protect our veterans and first responders, and educate the next generation of leaders.

Some of the bills I helped pass include measures to require schools to have cardiac emergency response plans (Ch. 189 of 2025), grant members of the New York Police Department eligibility for retirement and pension based on prior service as traffic enforcement agents (A.1778-C) and create an education and outreach program on reproductive health services available in our state (A.2581-B).
