SESSION GOALS



TACKLING THE OPIOID/FENTANYL CRISIS HEAD-ON AND KEEPING NEW YORKERS SAFE BY:

- ✓ **MAKING** all forms and doses of naloxone approved by the Food and Drug Administration available (A.10193, K. Brown, of 2024);
- ✓ **ESTABLISHING** the crime of criminal sale of a controlled substance resulting in death as a class A-1 felony (A.2021 of 2025); and
- ✓ **REQUIRING** the electronic cigarette and vaping prevention, awareness and control program to be used by all school districts in New York state (A.9952, K. Brown, of 2024).

BUILDING AN EMOTIONALLY SUPPORTIVE EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENT IN OUR SCHOOLS BY:

- ✓ **DIALING** back on cellphone usage during classroom instruction (A.9687, K. Brown, of 2024); and
- ✓ **PROTECTING** children from exploitative features in online products (A.8314, K. Brown, of 2024, Chapter 120 of the Laws of NYS 2024, Chapter 121 of the Laws of NYS 2024).

KEEPING THE ENVIRONMENT CLEAN AND IMPROVING WATER QUALITY AROUND LONG ISLAND BY:

- ✓ **REQUIRING** the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation to prohibit the sale of single-use plastic and polystyrene foam in state parks (A.1585, K. Brown, of 2025);
- ✓ **ASSISTING** with projects involving wastewater treatment facilities and individual septic system (Chapter 118 of the Laws of NYS 2024); and
- ✓ **REQUIRING** the establishment of electronics and hazardous waste recycling programs in Nassau and Suffolk counties (A.5567, K. Brown, of 2024).
