## *We have some ideas.*



### **JUDICIAL DISCRETION**

We can trust our judges to set bail if they see an offender has a history of breaking the law (A.4155)



### **EVALUATE DANGEROUSNESS**

We can empower justices to consider individual and community safety when determining pre-trial release for suspects (A.4206)



### **PUNISH GUN OFFENDERS**

Gun crimes should keep offenders off the street, which is not what New York established in 2019<sup>a</sup> (A.632)



### **PROTECTING LAW ENFORCEMENT**

We can label targeted crimes and graffiti against law enforcement as hate crimes (A.1159)
