New York has seen an alarming surge in antisemitic incidents. That's why Assemblyman Daniel Norber is taking action with real legislation to protect our communities:



The Dismantling Student Antisemitism (DSA) Act requires colleges to provide antisemitism awareness training and report incidents of antisemitic hate and discrimination.¹



The Antisemitism Vandalism Act makes it illegal to knowingly damage, destroy or remove pro-Israel signs and banners in public spaces.²



The Combating Campus Antisemitism Act ensures tuition assistance awards are not provided to any student who has knowingly incited lawless action with antisemitic intent.³



The Stop Anti-Semitism on College Campuses Act prevents any college that facilitates support for events promoting antisemitism on campus from receiving state aid.⁴

DID YOU KNOW?

- In New York City, antisemitic hate crimes surged by 74% in 2024.⁵
- New York State saw over one-third of the nation's antisemitic assaults in 2023⁶, with 94%⁶ of these incidents occurring in New York City or its surrounding suburbs, according to the Anti-Defamation League (ADL).
- ADL noted a 321% increase in antisemitic incidents on U.S. college campuses in the 2023-2024 academic year compared to the prior year, with New York universities like Columbia being a focal point.⁷

Assemblyman Norber's work is part of a broader mission to combat all forms of hate, ensuring every New Yorker feels safe and valued. Join us in building a stronger, more inclusive Long Island.
