**ASPHALT PAVEMENT RESURFACING  
NYS ROUTE 24 FROM MEADOWBROOK STATE PARKWAY TO  
NYS ROUTE 110 WITHIN THE TOWNS OF HEMPSTEAD, NASSAU COUNTY**

I am pleased to inform you that after many meetings & discussions, the New York State Department of Transportation's (NYSDOT) Asphalt Pavement Resurfacing project, NYS Route 24 from Meadowbrook State Parkway to NYS Route 110, has now entered the design phase of its development.

This project was initiated to restore the pavement riding surface by removing the existing asphalt overlay, repairing any damage to the underlying base pavement, and resurfacing with new asphalt.

The proposed pavement work will enhance motorist's safety and mobility by providing a smooth riding surface. This project will also install and/or upgrade sidewalk curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements. For your reference, NYSDOT has enclosed a location map for this project.

Please note, NYSDOT will be resurfacing the following locations as well.

- NYS Route 24 between Munson Avenue to North Franklin Street
- NYS Route 24 between Hendrickson Avenue to 0.2 miles west of Meadowbrook State Parkway
- NYS Route 102 between William Street and NYS Route 24

The construction phase of this project is tentatively scheduled to begin in the summer of 2026. In anticipation of community interest, NYSDOT and Assemblymember Noah Burroughs are happy to share this information.
