- **Stop dangerous battery energy storage** facilities from being built in residential areas — keeping them where they belong, far away from residential homes.¹
- **Protect election integrity** by ensuring only American citizens vote in our state elections.²
- **Advance critical safety improvements to the Nassau Expressway** — addressing long-overdue infrastructure and traffic concerns that impact our community every day.³
- **Protect Good Samaritans** who step in during emergencies — so doing the right thing doesn't come with legal risk.⁴
- **Require utility bills to show the real cost of Albany's climate mandates** — giving Long Islanders transparency on what these policies are adding to their monthly bills.⁵
- **Prevent local communities from being forced to house undocumented migrants** without their consent.⁶
