Fighting Higher Costs. One Bill At A Time.

A.7021 – Utility Bill Transparency

This legislation would require greater transparency regarding the true price of climate change measures on ratepayers’ utility bills.

A.4749 – Protect Water Ratepayers

Protects residents from unnecessary charges associated with advanced water metering infrastructure.

A.7798 – Protect New Yorkers From Unfunded Mandates

Establishes a temporary moratorium on unfunded mandates from the Legislature and creates regional mandate relief councils to lower costs for residents.

A.4819 – Fair Treatment for Long Island Commuters

Provides reimbursement for unused LIRR and Metro-North commuter tickets, helping commuters keep more of their hard-earned money.

A.8922 – Property Tax Relief

Provides targeted property tax relief for Nassau County volunteer auxiliary police officers in recognition of their service to our communities.
