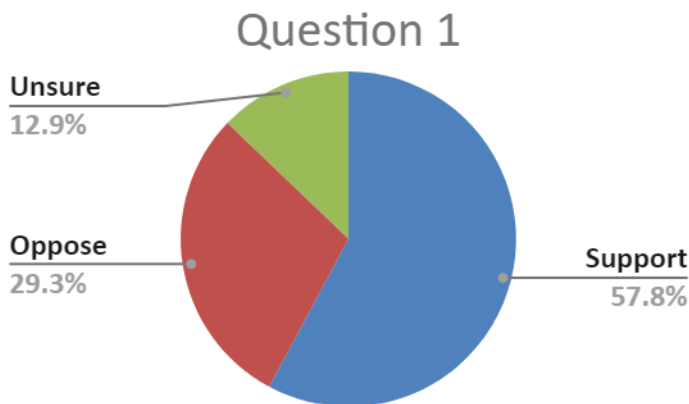


Assemblywoman Solages Releases 2022 Constituent Questionnaire Survey Results

Responses of the Twenty-Second Assembly District indicate their concerns with healthcare, law enforcement, and the environment, among other issues.

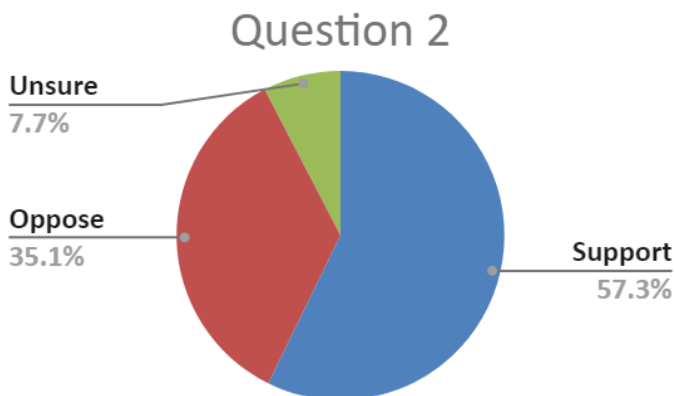

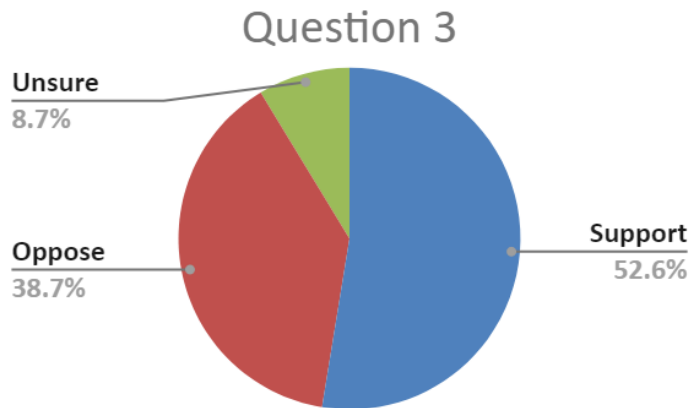


Basement apartments and other accessory dwelling units (ADUs) are not allowed in most of the state, but plenty exist nonetheless.

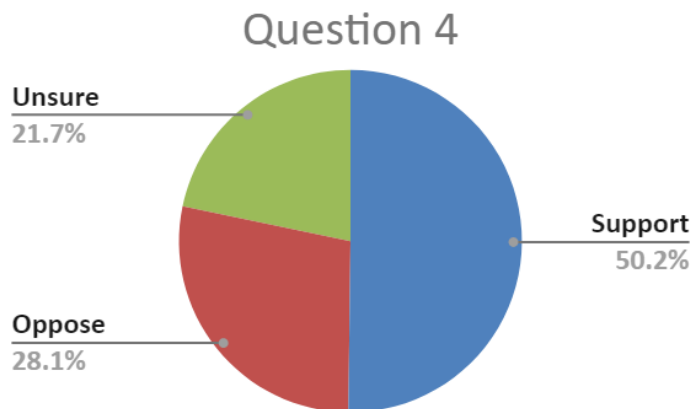

Question 3: Would You Support Legislation That Ensures Universal Healthcare In The State Of New York?

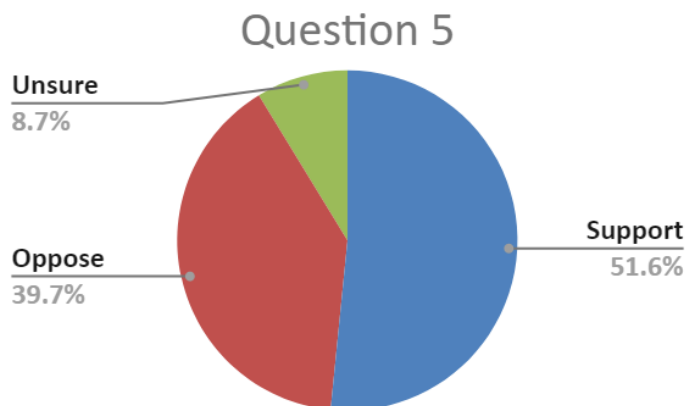


Question 4: Do You Support The Cancellation Of Medical Debt Acquired During The Covid-19 Pandemic?

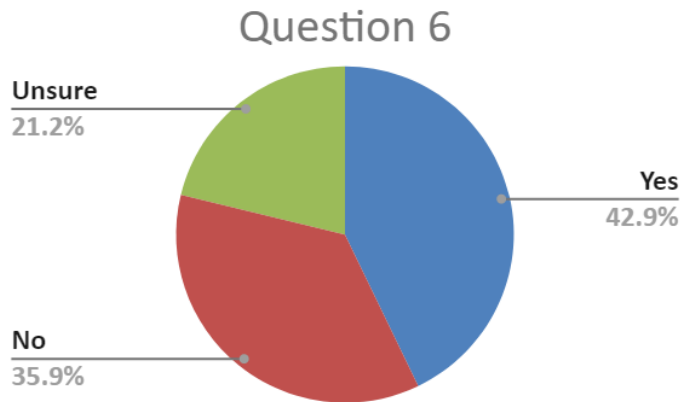


With the COVID-19 vaccine for children 5-11 recently approved, a new bill would require all New York students to be vaccinated in order to attend school.

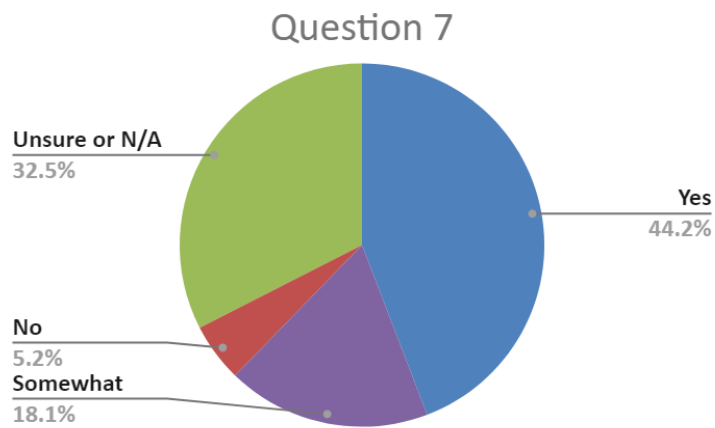
Question 5: Do You Support A New York State Mandate For The COVID-19 Vaccine For K-12 Students?



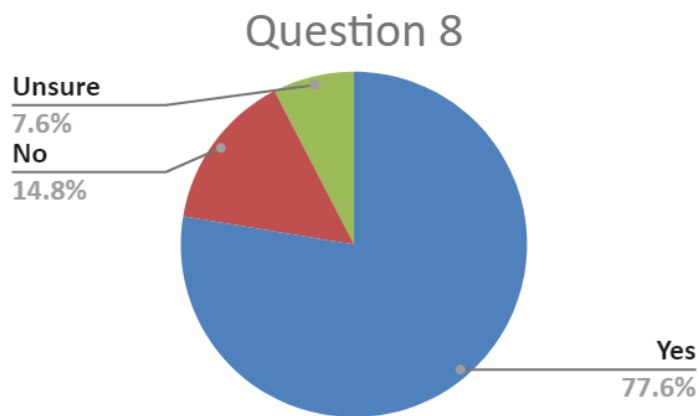
Question 6: Do you Believe That Forming A Union Would Benefit The Employees In Your Workplace?



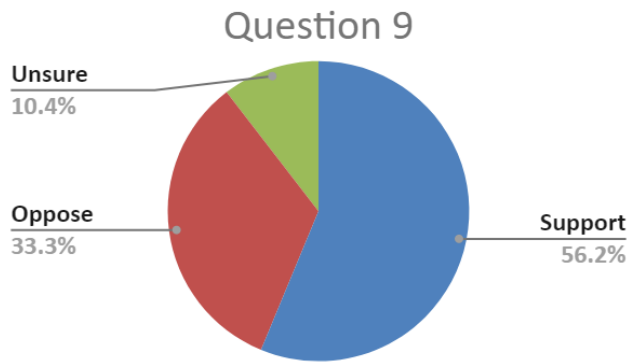
Question 7: Are COVID-19 Precautions Taken Seriously In Your Place Of Work?



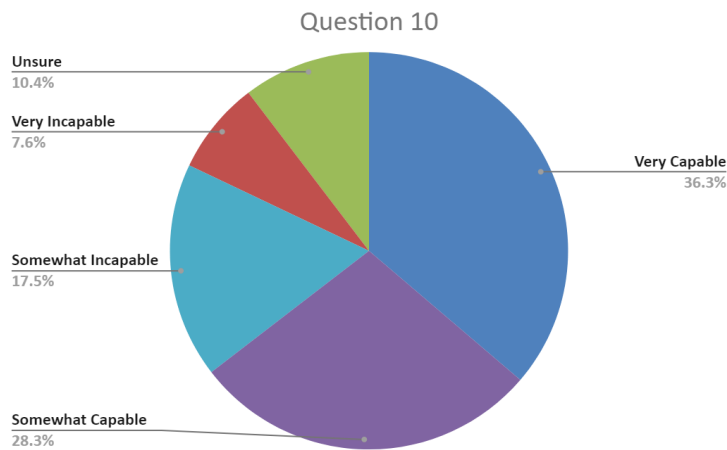
Question 8: Do You Believe All 4 Year Olds Should Have Access To Pre-K?



Question 9: Would You Support Legislation That Creates Universal Child Care In New York State?

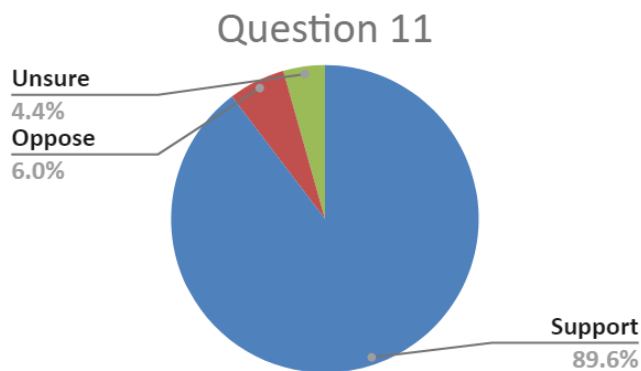

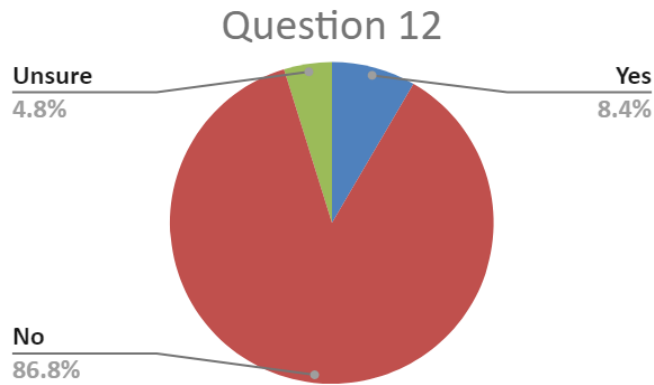


Currently, New York requires healthcare officials and law enforcement to report suspicions of elder abuse, but there is no requirement that these reports be investigated.

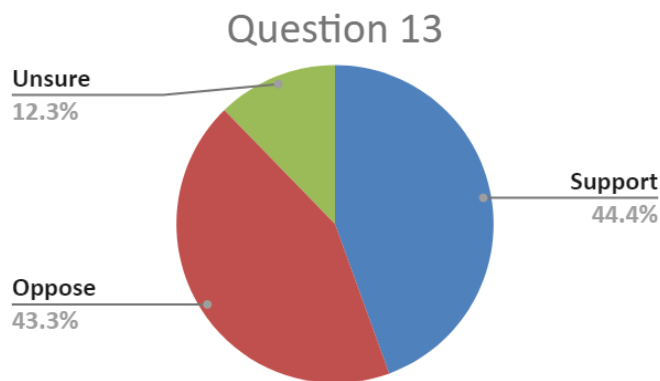
Question 11: Would You Support Legislation That Requires Law Enforcement To Investigate Suspicions Of Elder Abuse?



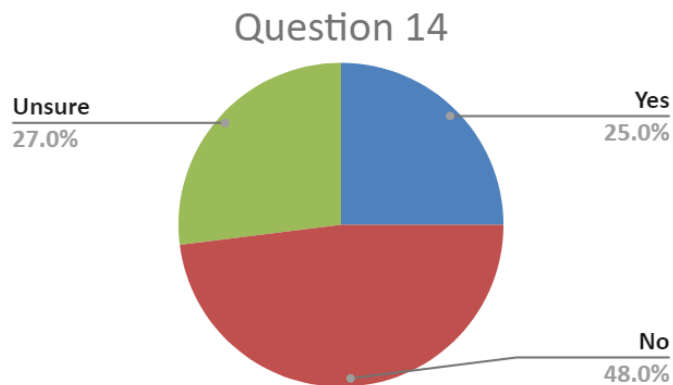
Question 12: Have You Witnessed Or Experienced An Instance Of Racial Profiling By Law Enforcement Within The Past Year?



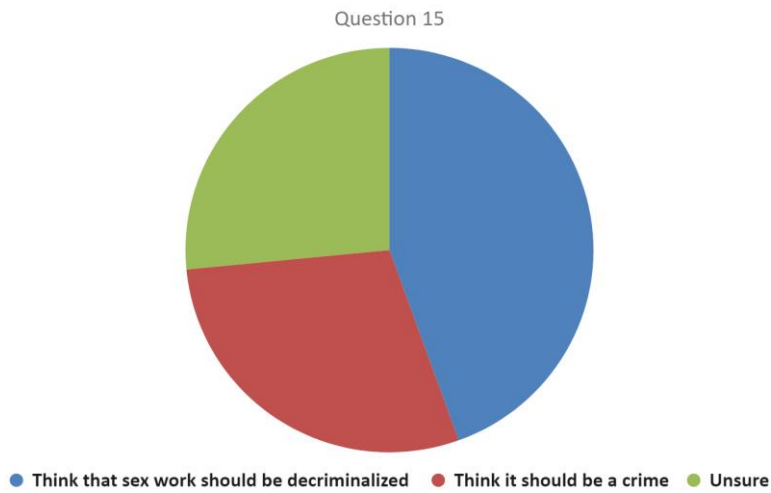
Question 13: Would You Support The Creation Of A Department Responsible For Enforcing Traffic Laws That Are Separate From The Police Department?



Question 14: Do You Believe There Are Too Many New Yorkers In Jail/prison?

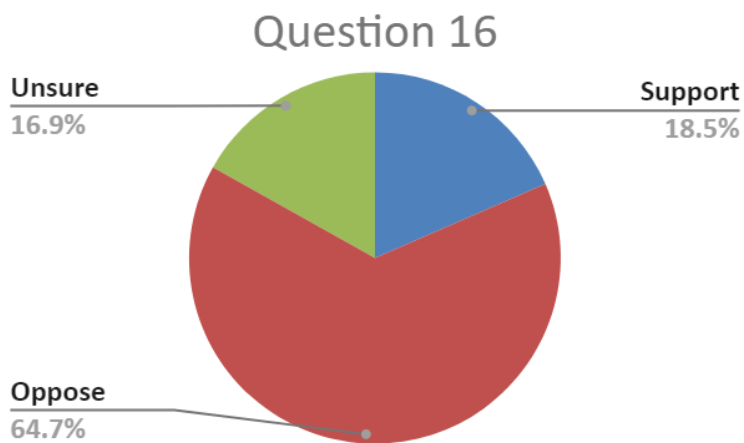


Question 15: Do You Think That Sex Work Between Consenting Adults Should Be Legal, Or Do You Think It Should Be A Crime



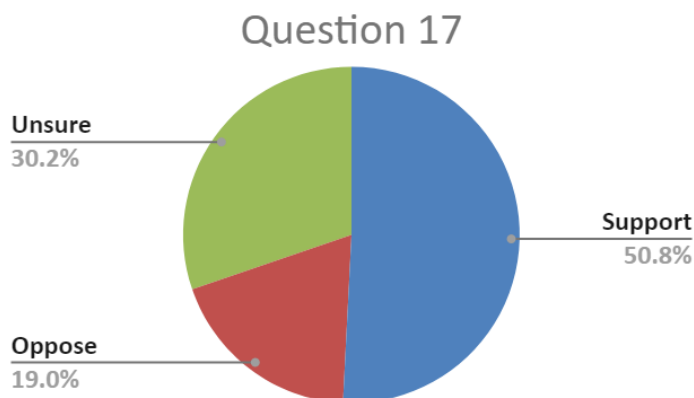
Some argue that cash bail unfairly targets low-income New Yorkers.

Question 16: Would you support New York State To Completely End Cash Bail?

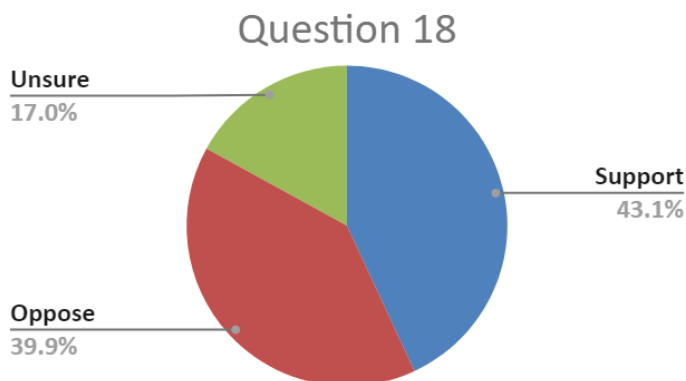

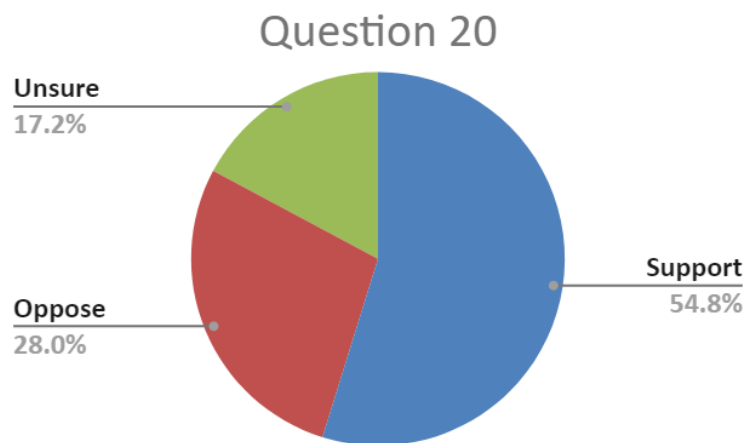

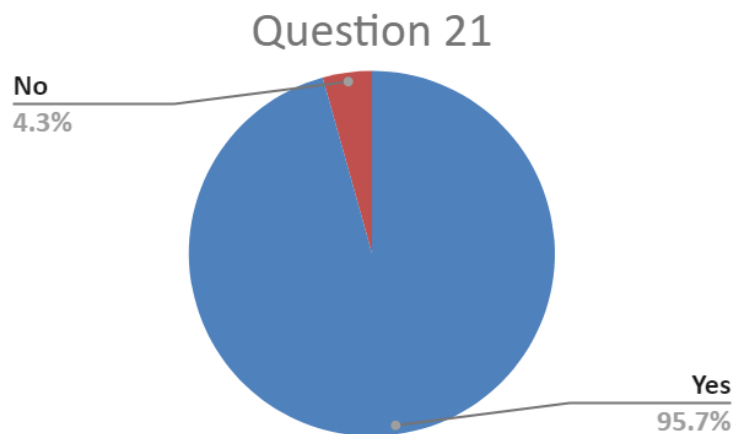
Question 19: Are You Negatively Impacted By Environmental Degradation (living Near A Waste Treatment Plant, Contaminated Water, Poor Air Quality)?



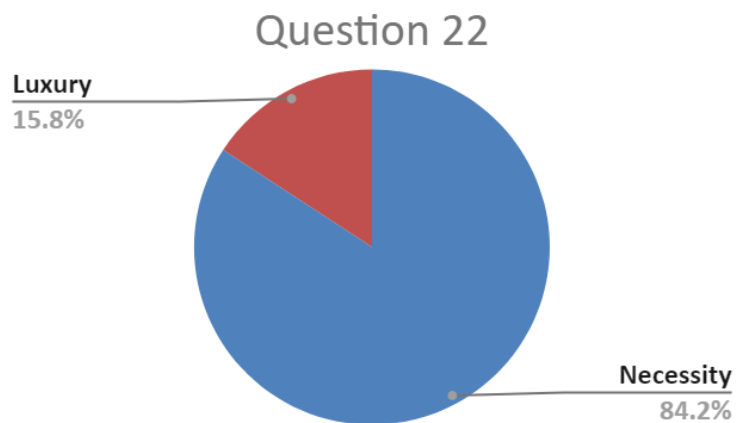
Question 20: Would You Support Greater Investment In Electric Car Charging Stations?



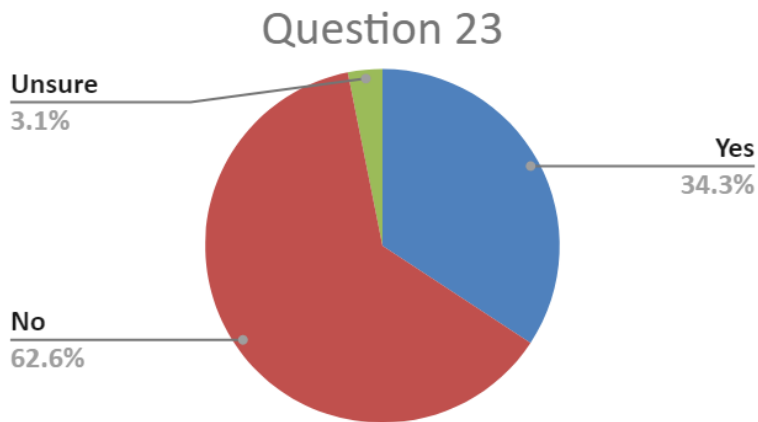
Question 21: Do You Find Voting An Easy And Accessible Way To Participate In Our Democracy?



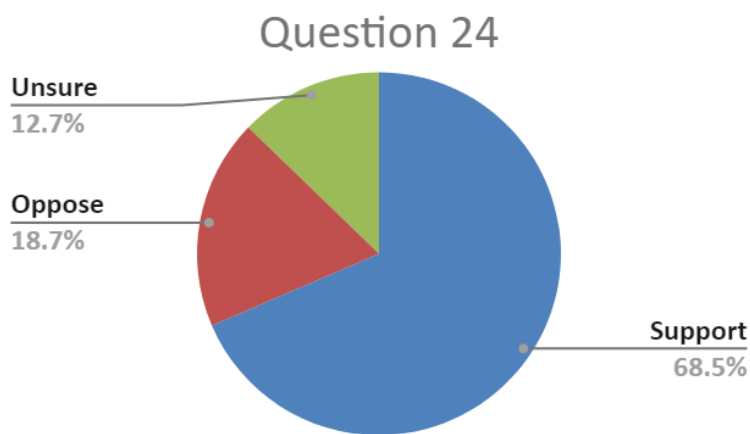
Question 22: Is Access To WIFI And/or The Internet A Luxury Or A Necessity?



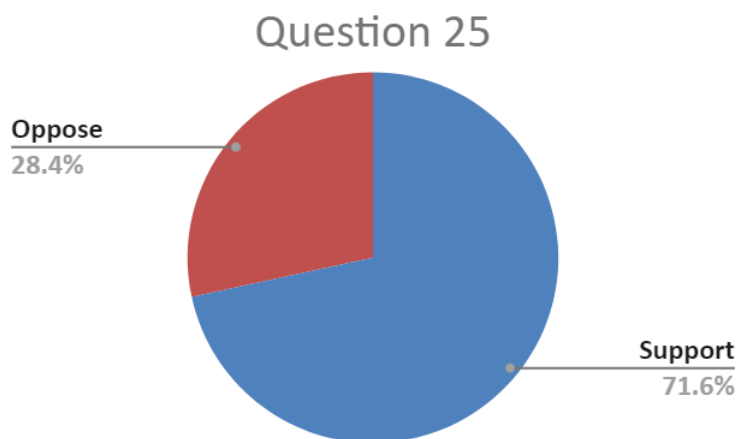
