3 WAYS TO SAVE:

1) Regular benefits

Regular HEAP benefits range from \$21 to \$675 plus additional benefits when applicable, and are based on income, the home's primary fuel source (such as oil, gas, propane or kerosene) and the number and ages of household members. For example, a household of four can earn up to \$60,228 annually and still qualify.

2) Emergency benefits

Emergency benefits are available for those who are eligible for HEAP and have an energy-related emergency such as a power shutoff, dangerously low levels of oil or propane or low supplies of wood.

3) Furnace repair or replacement

The HEAP furnace repair or replacement component is available to help low-income homeowners repair or replace furnaces, boilers and other direct-heating elements necessary to keep the home's primary heating source functional.


