Next Thursday, I am hosting a meeting along with Community Boards 7, 12, and 14; and City Council Members Shahana Hanif and Rita Joseph to hear a presentation from The New York City Department of Transportation about the proposed BQE traffic detours in 2023 that will impact Windsor Terrace and Kensington. You may have seen [reporting on the DOT's plan over the Summer](#).

These detours, which will include tractor trailer trucks and other oversized commercial vehicles, will be in effect while interim repairs are made on the BQE from March - October 2023. The current proposal, for three unspecified weekends, will divert all truck traffic to exit the Prospect Expressway on East 5th Street, which is a narrow one-way street with multiple playgrounds, a school and a library. 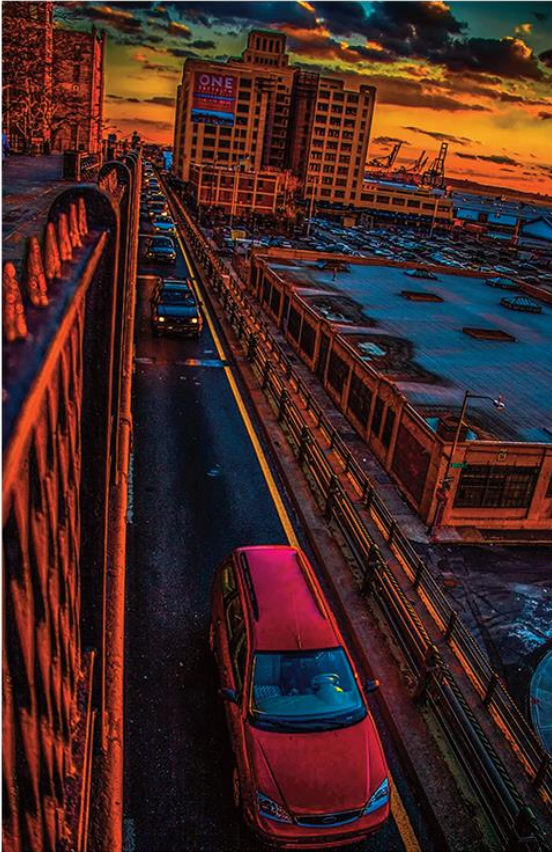
