Subway Safety Tips

- **1.Stay Aware:** Avoid distractions like headphones or phones; stay alert to your surroundings
- **2. Choose Crowded Areas:** Wait for your train in well-lit, busier sections of the platform and away from the edge of the platform
- **3. Keep Your Belongings Close:** Keep bags in front of you and valuables out of sight
- **4. Know Your Route:** Use apps like Google Maps, Citymapper or the MTA website to plan ahead
- **5. See Something, Say Something:** Use the NYC311 app or find an MTA employee if you see something concerning
