


Assembly Member Erik Martin Dilan passes law to **keep guns out of the hands of domestic violence abusers**



Assembly Member Erik Martin Dilan: We deserve a future free of gun violence

The Domestic Violence Escalation Prevention Act prohibits someone who has been convicted of a domestic violence crime from purchasing or possessing a firearm (A.10272).

Assembly Member Dilan also passed commonsense measures to prevent and reduce gun violence in New York and will keep fighting to make them law.

- ✓ Establish an “extreme risk protection order” to prohibit an individual who’s a threat to themselves or others from purchasing or possessing a firearm (A.8976-B)
- ✓ Ban the possession, manufacture and sale of bump stocks (A.9958)
- ✓ Establish a longer waiting period to ensure more thorough background checks (A.5025)
