Making **Bedford-Stuyvesant and Crown Heights** a safer place to call home

I supported new laws that crack down on crime:

RETAIL THEFT¹

- ✓ Provides **tax credits to small businesses** to support their security efforts
- ✓ Creates dedicated law enforcement teams to **combat organized retail theft rings**
- ✓ Increases punishments for those who participate in theft, assault a retail worker or foster the sale of stolen goods

HATE CRIMES¹

- ✓ Provides **\$35 million** to protect organizations at risk of hate crimes

STREET SAFETY

- ✓ Supporting legislation that establishes **safety requirements for e-bike operators** and for the businesses that employ such operators (A.9805)²
- ✓ Provides enhancements for toll enforcement and ticketing procedures against those who try and skip out on tolls by obscuring license plates¹

ILLEGAL CANNABIS¹

- ✓ Authorizes the state Office of Cannabis Management to **shut down and padlock illegal cannabis dealers** and strengthens local enforcement powers
