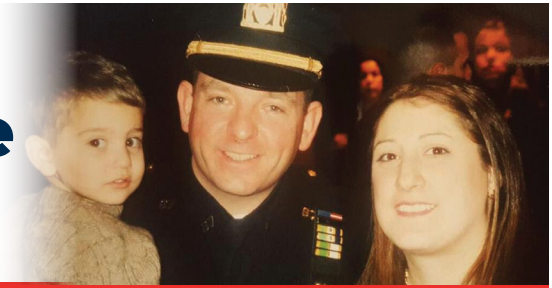

## Safer Schools

Reilly led the charge and successfully brought camera-based, door-locking security systems to NYC public schools<sup>1</sup> and has been outspoken about the need for more school safety agents to keep our students and teachers safe<sup>2</sup>.

Reilly sued Mayor Eric Adams and the City of New York to block their warehousing of migrants at the former site of St. John Villa Academy<sup>3</sup> and opposed the automatic sealing of criminal records through the Clean Slate Act<sup>4</sup>.

## Safer Businesses

Reilly successfully advocated for legislative action to combat the rise in serial shoplifting and organized retail theft. For the first time ever, prosecutors are allowed to combine the value of items stolen through a common scheme or plan and charge individuals responsible with grand larceny<sup>5</sup>.
