Funding Our Staten Island Community

Grants

I was able to secure a \$75,000 grant for On Your Mark and the Joan & Alan Bernikow Jewish Community Center (JCC), both vital institutions in our community. These grants instituted through the State and Municipal Facilities Program will pave the way for significant upgrades to each of these organizations' facilities and help to serve as a beacon of opportunity and support for all Staten Islanders.



School Aid Grants

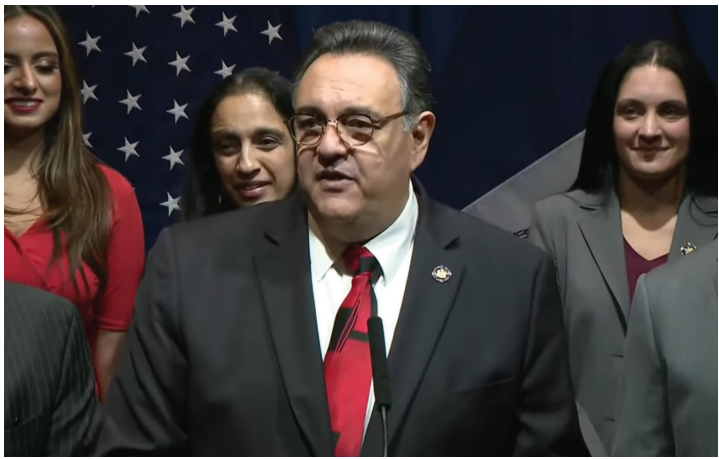
I had the privilege of presenting PS 30, The Westerleigh School, PS 69, Daniel D. Tompkins School, PS 45, John Tyler School, PS 13, M.L. Lindemeyer School and Susan E. Wagner High School each with \$20,000 grants totaling \$100,000 in aid.³ As an advocate for education, these grants are a testament to my commitment to providing students with the resources they need to thrive. Education is a priority, by investing in public schools, we're investing in the future of America.

Verrazzano Narrows Bridge Resident Toll Relief

I supported the Verrazzano Narrows Bridge Resident Toll Relief, which totaled \$22.5 million in aid.² This funding offers a percentage rebate for Staten Island residents crossing the Verrazzano Narrows Bridge.

Opioid Addiction Treatment

I helped announce \$12 million in funding that was secured over a four-year period for opioid addiction treatment in Staten Island.⁴ With this money, Staten Island can bolster its efforts in prevention, treatment, and recovery, marking a significant step forward in combating opioid addiction.
