Putting more money into your pockets

The 2022-23 state budget provides:

- ***\$4.5 billion*** for a new 5-year Affordable Housing Capital Plan
- **Nearly *\$3 billion*** for child care to expand eligibility for subsidized care
- ***\$1.1 billion*** for the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) and Landlord Rental Assistance Program (LRAP)
- ***\$475 million*** for an additional Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit payment
- ***\$250 million*** to help New Yorkers catch up on utility bills
