NYCHA Announces Extended Office Hours

The New York City Housing Authority (NYCHA) announced today the start of extended summertime property management office hours at developments across the City. Staff are now available on Wednesdays, from 8:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m., to provide assistance to public housing residents.

As part of the Authority's ongoing efforts to improve the quality of life for its residents, NYCHA has rolled out extended hours for all property management offices in its over 300 developments. Staff will help residents with rent payment issues, assistance with completing annual income recertifications and interim recertifications, and scheduling maintenance appointments with management staff. The extended hours will conclude August 28.

NYCHA asks that all residents continue to use the MyNychaApp or call the Customer Contact Center at 718-707-7771 to create a work order ticket for any maintenance needs or issues in their apartment.

Census 2020 Grants for Community Organizations & Job Openings!

The census is coming. In 2020, the federal government will conduct the decennial census, a count of everyone living in the United States. A complete count is key to ensuring funding and representation in Congress are fairly distributed.

Communities like ours are at risk of being under-counted. The Manhattan Borough President has launched a Complete Count Committee and is also funding NYC-based, culturally competent efforts to help communicate the importance of the census to Manhattan neighborhoods. Community organizations may apply for small grants to reach historically under-counted communities in Manhattan. The deadline to apply is August 2, 2019.
