Today I held a special district meeting with U.S. Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer for community leaders of the Upper East Side, Yorkville and Roosevelt Island. The meeting with the New York senior senator at the Lenox Hill Neighborhood House was for our community to hear from the Senator on federal aid for tenants, small businesses, transportation, health, education and other vital issues of community concern. Attendees included advocates, activists, non-profit representatives, local school leaders, and local hospital healthcare officials.

This past weekend I was proud to stand with the Roosevelt Island community as the Franklin D. Roosevelt Hope Memorial was unveiled. It was a beautiful day to see the brand new memorial that celebrates FDR's disability. My office was able to secure a one hundred and fifty thousand dollar donation from an anonymous constituent to help bring this project across the finish line.

This week, legislation that I was proud to co-sponsor was signed into law. It increases the age of consent for purposes of marriage to the age of eighteen. This law strengthens and builds upon laws passed in 2017. The purpose of these bills is to combat human and sex trafficking by ending forced marriages between adults and children


