# Rebecca Seawright



Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Along with my colleagues on the Assembly Judiciary Committee, I have been in Albany this week examining materials compiled by the committee's special counsel investigating Governor Cuomo as well as the comprehensive report of Attorney General James. These materials include interviews of key witnesses, electronic documents such as emails, text messages, files obtained under subpoena, and other evidence.

The work I have reviewed of both the Attorney General and Assembly Judiciary staff clearly demonstrate that we are moving in the right direction by pursuing a final committee report. I was among the first to call for a comprehensive and publicly available committee report detailing its findings, recommendations as well as referrals to appropriate law enforcement agencies. We owe a full accounting to the people of New York to help serve as the basis for assuring that new safeguards going forward are subsequently adopted.

The highly transmissible Delta variant is now the dominant coronavirus strain in the United States, accounting for 98% of cases. The Biden administration said it would begin offering coronavirus booster shots the week of September 20, after concluding that a third shot is needed to fight off waning immunity. Immunocompromised individuals are currently eligible for a booster. Officials said those who received the Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna vaccines can receive a booster shot eight months after the date when they received their second vaccine dose. Officials said they are waiting for additional data before setting a plan for people who received the one-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

This week Mayor Bill de Blasio announced the Key to NYC vaccination mandate for indoor dining, entertainment and fitness that began August 17. There are a few ways to show you are vaccinated for entry including the NYS Excelsior Pass, the NYC COVID Safe App or your vaccination record.

#### New York State Homeowner Assistance Fund

The New York State Homeowner Assistance Fund ("NYS HAF") was established under section 3206 of the *American Rescue Plan Act of 2021* and provides \$539,458,518 in financial assistance to New York State, through the United States Department of the Treasury. The aim of HAF is to mitigate financial hardships associated with the coronavirus pandemic by preventing homeowner mortgage delinquencies, defaults, foreclosures, loss of utilities or home energy services, and displacements of homeowners experiencing financial hardship. *HCR will begin accepting applications in September 2021*.

#### **Emergency Rental Assistance Program**

New Yorkers who have been unable to pay rent due to the impacts of COVID-19 can apply for help through the NYS Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP). #### Open Restaurants / Sidewalk Cafes Text Amendment

The New York City Department of Transportation (DOT) and Department of City Planning (DCP) are proposing a citywide zoning text amendment that will allow the DOT to administer the Permanent Open Restaurant program (POR). The proposal will remove sidewalk café regulations from the Zoning Resolution to increase geography eligibility as sidewalk cafes will become part of a unified sidewalk and roadway outdoor dining program administered at DOT.
