Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Wishing all of the incredible mothers in our community a wonderful Mother's Day Weekend.

I have been hard at work fighting for protections for our older New Yorkers from financial scams. I was honored to join Assembly Member Clyde Vanel, Senator James Sanders, Chair of the Senate Aging Committee Senator Cordell Cleare, and advocates from AARP to advocate for passage of Assembly Bill 10899, which would strengthen consumer protections for individuals using cryptocurrency kiosks to conduct financial transactions. Older adults have been targeted at a disproportionate rate in fraud and scams conducted using cryptocurrency kiosks with over 85% of theft losses in cryptocurrency kiosk fraud impacting those aged 60 and up for a total loss of over \$107 million in 2024.

Additionally, I have introduced legislation to require insurers participating in the New York State of Health Marketplace to offer at least one dental plan for individuals 65 and up. Many older New Yorkers, most of whom live on a fixed income, are experiencing large financial strain from the rise of the cost of living. Ensuring that our older New Yorkers have access to dental coverage through the New York State of Health Marketplace is one of my top priorities throughout the remainder of our 2026 Legislative Session.

SPOTLIGHT ON AGING:

Seawright Fights Cryptocurrency Kiosk Scams



Assembly Member Rebecca A. Seawright joined Assembly Member Clyde Vanel, Senator James Sanders Jr., Senate Aging Committee Chair Cordell Cleare, and advocates from AARP in support of Assembly Bill 10899, legislation aimed at increasing consumer safeguards for people using cryptocurrency kiosks for financial transactions.

The legislation comes amid a sharp rise in cryptocurrency kiosk scams disproportionately targeting older adults. In 2024 alone, individuals aged 60 and older accounted for more than 85% of reported theft losses connected to these scams, totaling over \$107 million. Seawright has continued to advocate for stronger protections to help shield older New Yorkers from financial exploitation and fraud.
