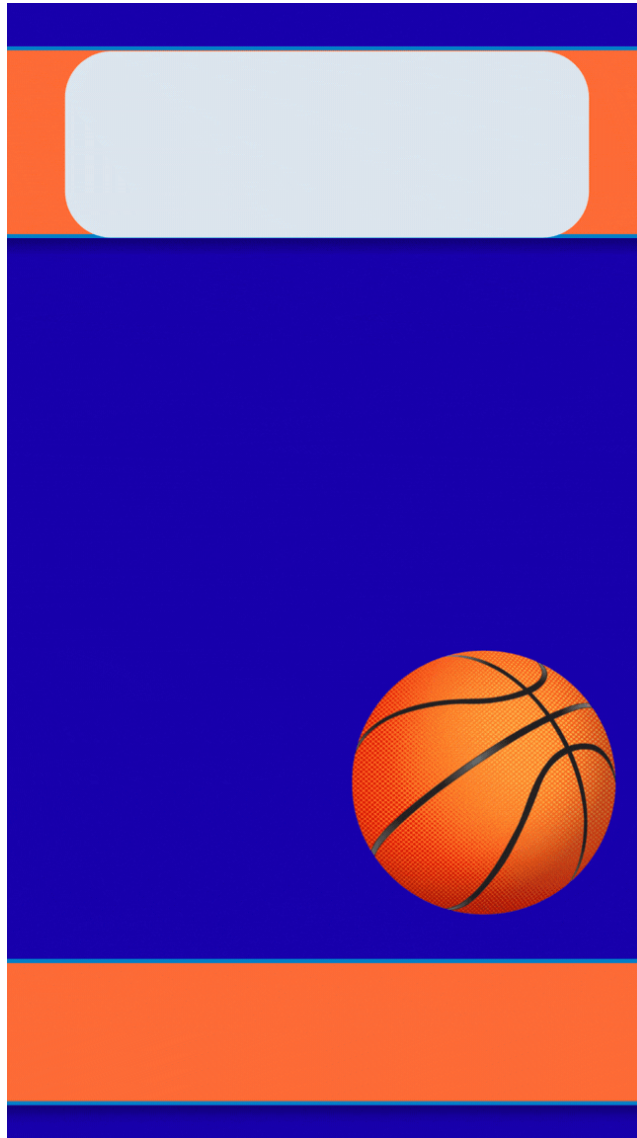

June 13 – June 21, 2026: Early Voting Period- Vote before Election Day at your designated early voting site.

June 22, 2026: Last day to request a mail ballot in person.

June 23, 2026 PRIMARY ELECTION DAY!: Polls are open from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

June 23, 2026: Last day to submit your completed mail ballot.
