# Assemblyman Nader Sayegh: Addressing our priorities, investing in our community

### Supporting local schools and higher education

- ➤ \$49.5 million for the development, maintenance and expansion of magnet schools within the Yonkers City School District
- ► Almost \$1.15 million for the Yonkers City School District for teacher support
- ► Established a universal free school meals program so students can focus on learning
- ▶ Established *bell-to-bell restrictions on smartphones* in schools to eliminate distractions
- Created the New York Opportunity Promise Scholarship to provide free community college tuition to students aged 25-55 who are pursuing careers in high-demand fields, such as technology, nursing and teaching
- > \$2.5 billion in capital funding for SUNY to improve its campuses
- ► \$8 million in additional operating funds for SUNY community colleges

# Saving New Yorkers money

- ► Cut income tax rates for approximately 8.3 million New Yorkers
- ▶ Provided up to a \$400 inflation refund check to millions of residents
- ▶ Increased the maximum child tax credit from \$330 to \$1,000 for kids under age 4
- ► Expanded eligibility for the STAR property tax relief program by easing age and income requirements for homeowners

#### Investing in our health care system

- ▶ \$500 million for financially distressed hospitals
- ▶ \$20 million for renovations to the Saint Joseph's Medical Center (2023-24 NYS Budget)
- ► \$450 million for improvements to St. John's Hospital
- ► \$30 million in additional funding for nursing home rates
- > \$7 million for maternal health grants

# Supporting our families

- ➤ Established the BABY Benefit pregnancy allowance, providing public assistance recipients with a one-time, *\$1,800* cash benefit following the birth of a new child
- ► Invested *\$55 million* for Nourish NY and *\$58 million* for the Hunger Prevention Nutrition Assistance Program

# Assemblyman Sayegh and his colleagues worked to pass the following laws and funding initiatives to support Yonkers:

- ► \$1.3 million for Armour Villa Neighborhood Flooding Mitigation project with construction beginning in the spring (2023-24 NYS Budget)
- ▶ \$100k for renovations to the Yonkers Fire Station (2021-22 NYS Budget)
- ▶ \$100k for operating and service expenses of the Hudson River Museum (2025-26 NYS Budget)
- ► \$4 million for renovations and improvements to the Yonkers Police Athletic League (2023-24 NYS Budget)
- ▶ \$300k for Improvements to Andrus Park (2024-25 NYS Budget)
- ▶ \$125k for vehicle funding for the Yonkers Office of Aging (2021-22 NYS Budget)
- ➤ \$1.5 million for renovations and improvements to St. John's Methadone Clinic (2023-24 NYS Budget)
- ► Requiring school safety plans to include a cardiac emergency response plan (Ch. 189 of 2025)
- ► Limiting a homeowner's requirement when purchasing flood insurance and providing notice of minimum insurance liability that is required (Ch. 64 of 2025)
- ► Allowing employers and unions to negotiate layoff rights that exceed what is in civil service law (Ch. 361 of 2025)
- ► Transferring Alzheimer's outreach and education programs to the Department of Health (Ch. 47 of 2025)
- ► Requiring allergen labeling on all prepackaged foods (Ch. 494 of 2025)
