2026 LEGISLATIVE SESSION HIGHLIGHTS



- ✓ **A path to universal Pre-K** for all four-year-old children statewide for the 2028-29 school year. (FY 2027 Budget)
- ✓ **The most comprehensive utility rate-setting reforms in decades**, including my bill to limit utilities from charging to ratepayers their costs in pursuing rate hikes. (A5402B; FY 2027 Budget)

- ✓ **Protecting immigrant communities** by prohibiting local government cooperation in federal civil immigration matters and designating sensitive locations where ICE may not conduct enforcement (including schools and polling locations). (FY 2027 Budget)
- ✓ **An expanded Veterans Property Tax Exemption**, giving local governments the option to provide a full property tax exemption for veterans who have a service-related permanent and total disability. (FY 2027 Budget)

- ✓ **A one-year moratorium** on new permits for data centers. (A11560)
- ✓ **Traveling with Dignity Act**, which I sponsored, and which sets the state on the course for one of the nation's most comprehensive programs for installing adult changing accommodations in public spaces, essential for adults with mobility limitations. (A6219B)
- ✓ **I am proud to have led the effort to secure key funding**, including \$400 million for the SUNY system for critical maintenance and SUNY Research Facilities; \$75 million for Public Housing Authorities outside of New York City, and \$4 million for students with disabilities in state colleges and universities. (FY 2027 Budget)
