## **Assemblyman Matt Slater is Fighting for Kent**

Assemblyman Slater helped secure over \$5 million in state funding for important projects in Kent. This funding will improve local roads and invest in our community, while easing the burden on property taxpayers.

- \$1.1 million to repair and resurface Kent's roads<sup>1</sup>
- \$3.6 million to resurface Route 52<sup>2</sup>
- \$20,000 for the Kent Public Library's community room<sup>3</sup>
- \$119,000 for the Putnam County Sheriff's Office and \$150,000 for the Kent Police Department to purchase new technology and equipment, including license plate readers, cameras, unmanned aerial vehicles and smart vehicle technology.<sup>4</sup>
- \$255,000 for Putnam County 911<sup>5</sup>

Assemblyman Slater also helped pass new measures allowing advertising revenue to be used to invest in Kent's parks and baseball fields.<sup>6</sup>
