Assemblyman Tague's efforts to bring hope and aid against this crisis:

- Sponsoring legislation that makes insurance companies cover a full detox and rehabilitation services. (A.4721)
- Establish limitations on the amount of opioids prescribed to a patient. (A.4778)
- Fighting to make possession of fentanyl a class E felony, known as the Death-by-Dealer Statute. (A.3398)
- Promoting awareness groups to bring our communities closer together and help those who need it the most.
