FIGHTING FOR YOU IN ALBANY TO PROTECT OUR QUALITY OF LIFE

DURING THE LAST LEGISLATIVE SESSION, CHRIS HELPED SECURE:

- Permanent extension of the Real Property Tax Cap, capping it at 2 percent. (A.2009-C)
- Restoration of the \$65 million Extreme Winter Recovery Program, which was cut during this year's budget negotiations. (A.8434)
- Administrative action to expand eligibility for free college to the children, spouses, and financial dependents of military members who died in performance of their official duties. (A.2991)

FOUGHT AGAINST POLICIES THAT ARE HARMFUL TO OUR QUALITY OF LIFE:

- When legislators proposed a harmful farm labor bill, I fought back. I understand the struggles our small family farms endure day to day. We do not need to put more burdens on them. (A.8419)
- I voted against "The Green Light Bill," granting driver's licenses to illegal immigrants. (A.3675-B)
- I voted against the "DREAM Act," which grants free college tuition assistance to illegal immigrants in New York State. (A.782)
- I stood up against the "Red Flag Bill," which could weaken our Second Amendment rights and that could wrongfully take away your firearms without due process. (A.2689)
